This middle-class community continually works to maintain and upgrade its neighborhoods and housing stock. In recent years the City has been proactive in revitalizing its commercial centers along Gratiot Avenue and Nine Mile Road so residents have access to modern shopping facilities and a vast array of necessary services.

Fraser

Incorporated in 1957, Fraser saw its largest growth during the 1960's. Consisting primarily of single-family residential neighborhoods Fraser has been able to keep its small town feel while benefiting from nearby amenities one would expect in a suburban environment. Its limited industrial activity is in the Fraser Industrial Park located in the Northeast section of the city.
